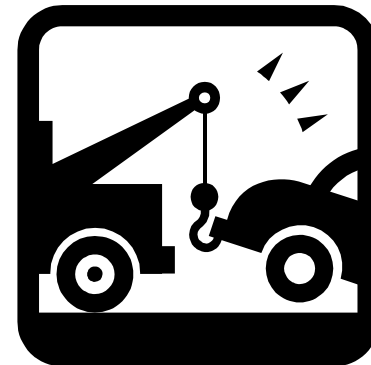
**Towing Hours:** 24 hours a day/7 days a week

Towing fees are as follows:

**Impound Fee:** \$125 if vehicle is picked up within the  
first 24 hours (fees subject to change w/o notice)  
**Storage Fee:** \$25 per day in storage everyday after  
first 24 hours (fees subject to change w/o notice)  
**Payment:** Cash, Visa, MasterCard

### **Dominion Towing Company:**

Take Route 1 South  
Turn right on Fairfax County Parkway (Route 7100)  
Turn left on Terminal Road  
Dominion Towing is on the right at 8474 Terminal  
Road, Lorton, VA 22079.

- A. This towing policy applies to PLHA private streets and service roads only.
- B. A tow truck service will randomly patrol the community on a 24/7 basis and upon request.
- C. PLHA ASSUMES NO LIABILITY FOR DAMAGE TO ANY VEHICLE. COMPLAINTS OF IMPROPERLY TOWED VEHICLES SHOULD BE MADE DIRECTLY TO DOMINION TOWING.
- D. Parking on PLHA private streets and service roads is defined in PLHA Policy Resolution 2006-03.
- E. Parking on PLHA private streets and service roads is reserved for current residents and their invited guests only.
- F. No major maintenance of vehicles as defined in PLHA Policy Resolution 2006-03 shall be performed on the PLHA private streets and service roads.
- G. Violations of the below-listed items and the contents of Pinewood Lake Homeowners Association (PLHA) Policy Resolution 2006-03 will result in subject vehicles being towed at owner's expense.
  - 1. Parked vehicles must have current license plates and/or a current state inspection sticker.
  - 2. No trucks having a gross weight in excess of 7500 pounds, commercial vehicles (as defined by PLHA Policy Resolution 2006-03), vehicles in excess of 18 feet in length, school buses, inoperable vehicles (including flat tires), trailers, campers, motor homes or other similar recreational vehicles shall be parked on private streets or service roads. This item does not apply to commercial vehicles temporarily parked to conduct business.
  - 3. Vehicles shall not be parked in areas marked as fire lanes or painted yellow denoting no parking, next to fire hydrants, partially or fully across sidewalks/aprons or partially or fully blocking driveways or service roads.
  - 4. No vehicle shall be double parked.
  - 5. No vehicle shall be parked in a handicapped parking space without a government-issued handicapped sticker or license plate.
